Direct Service Training

The Women's Center, Inc. offers a 60-hour counselor/advocacy training course. This training is open to the public for individuals who want to assist staff in providing services to victims/survivors of domestic and sexual violence. The training is a culmination of online training modules, virtual sessions with staff, and hands-on experience. The training costs \$10, after the volunteer has completed the course and given back 12 hours of volunteer services, they are reimbursed the \$10.
