# Domestic Violence Awareness Month

October is Domestic Violence Awareness Month; according to The Pennsylvania Coalition Against Domestic Violence (PCADV), there are more than 10 million people each year who are abused in the U.S. In Pennsylvania, there were 109 victims who died from domestic violence incidents in 2020 alone. Domestic violence is a pattern of coercive behavior used by one person to gain power and control over another in an intimate or familial relationship. Domestic violence can be characterized by different types of abuse including emotional abuse, physical abuse, stalking, sexual violence, financial abuse, and verbal abuse.

The Women's Center, Inc. of Columbia and Montour counties provides free and confidential support services to victims of domestic violence, sexual assault, and incest. These services include; Individual and group counseling, emergency shelter, medical advocacy and accompaniment, legal advocacy and accompaniment, and education programs.
